Co-designed with parents of children with medical complexities, VHA Playdate gives kids who are medically fragile a rare chance to have a blast with other kids who are just like them! VHA Playdate is like no other program in that it is:

VHA Playdate was featured on CTV News during our pilot session in Fall 2016. Since then, it has gained attention from parents of VHA clients and we have a waitlist for future playdates since each session only accommodates 15 children.

While VHA donates the administrative support needed to sustain this program, we are looking for a longer-term partner to continue our strategic mandate to support children with medical complexities and help ensure these children get this unique chance to socialize, play and enjoy a weekend afternoon of sheer fun.

Despite the program's overwhelming success, we continue to seek out long-term funding to keep this important initiative going.

• A chance for kids to engage in play as fully as possible despite significant developmental delays. The program provides on-site nursing interventions that enable safe participation including tube feedings, medication, seizure management, suctioning and oxygen therapy.

RAISING KIDS WITH COMPLEX **MEDICAL NEEDS CAN BE DIFFICULT.**

Some of the challenges include balancing work and care needs, booking time off for appointments and the costs associated with typical respite *care* or making hospital visits, hospital parking fees, etc.

This is why VHA is committed to always keeping the program free of charge.

VHA Playdate provides one-on-one care services from healthcare professionals.

Typical respite programs do not always meet the nursing needs of children with medical complexities. VHA Playdate is specifically designed for children who are medically fragile and technology dependent. Parents feel their children are safe and are able to participate as fully as possible in play while they are gone.

It provides a safe space for children with complex medical needs to socialize.

Children with complex medical needs can sometimes feel isolated at school. VHA Playdate focuses on group-based activities such as parachute play or obstacle courses because these kids respond with delight when other children are present. Bringing these children together for a playdate is different than being at home or school because it's all about fun!

- Staff to help the kids play, ensure their safety and to give parents peace of mind (each child has support from a Personal Support Worker throughout the day, an Occupational Therapist who leads activities and three nurses who are on hand in case of a medical event).

The Cost of VHA Playdate

While the benefits for the kids and parents are priceless, the VHA Playdate program requires people power and financial resources to run.

It starts with a home visit to meet each child and family, discuss the goals and possibilities of the program and assess each child's unique developmental and medical needs. This results in appropriate play and support for each child and also helps families develop positive relationships with our team. Up to now, the program has been limited to VHA clients. But with ongoing investment, we hope to expand the service to all kids in the GTA who qualify.

The approximate cost breakdown per six-week VHA Playdate session is:

Facility rental: \$5,500 OT facilitator fees: \$2,400 Nurse fees: \$3,840 PSW fees: \$9,120 Activity fees: \$200 Special guests: \$1,200 Refreshments and snacks: \$60

Thus, the individualized care, fees for supplies, staff, entertainment, refreshments and rental costs add up to about **\$1,500 per child for** each six-week session.
