#### When Should I Call My Doctor?

- Fever in a child less than 6 months old
- Fever for more than 72 hours
- Excessive sleepiness
- Rapid or difficulty breathing
- Coughing that won't go away (lasts more than a week) or is severe and causes choking or vomiting
- Diarrhea in a child younger than 6 months of age
- Bloody or black stools
- Vomiting for more than 4 hours
